CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Steve Brock called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. A quorum was confirmed for the meeting.

Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Jannine Miller provided the Executive Report, highlighting the historic first competitive process for the Transit Trust Fund, which generated innovative proposals and strong partnerships with local governments and transit operators.

Miller congratulated Alex Wan on his unopposed campaign and Marci Collier Overstreet on her election as Atlanta City Council President.

Miller confirmed no impact from the recent federal funding authorization lapse and presented the statutorily required Transit Report for 2024, emphasizing streamlined data reporting, MARTA's role as the largest operator with over 3 million vehicle revenue hours in 2024, \$1.2 billion in regional transit funding, and the safest year on record for incidents.

Miller congratulated Commissioner Russell McMurry on his election as president of the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, reaffirming Georgia's leadership in transportation policy. She also highlighted MARTA's NextGen bus network redesign, the I-285 transit plan, and ATL's Strategic Blueprint.

Miller noted recent federal transit awards, and celebrated the Georgia Transit Association's Innovation Award to the ATL for "Redefine the Ride."

Miller concluded her report by giving a Commendation to ATL employee Charles Fleming upon his retirement after 37 years of service.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

REGIONAL TRANSIT PLANNING COMMITTEE

Chairman Steve Brock provided the Board with a report summarizing the Regional Transit Planning Committee meeting held on December 4, 2025. The following resolution was presented in the Regional Transit Planning Committee in preparation for Board consideration.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ALLOCATION OF THE FY25 TRANSIT TRUST FUND AWARDS

Chairman Steve Brock called for a motion approving the FY25 Transit Trust Fund Awards. Mr. Ricky Clark made the motion to approve the resolution which was seconded by Ms. Marlene Fosque. The Board unanimously approved the resolution.

Board Member Mr. Ricky Clark recognized Dr. Alieka Anderson-Henry, Chair of the Clayton County Board of Commissioners, to address the board. Dr. Anderson-Henry expressed her gratitude for the FY25 Transit Trust Fund Award to Clayton County in support of the Southern Crescent Transit Study.
