ZEB FLEET TRANSITION PLAN- STATE OF ZEB'S IN THE TRANSIT MARKET

Abby Marinelli gave a presentation on the Regional ZEB Fleet Transition Plan. A ZEB Fleet Transition Plan is a required component of the Bus and Bus Facilities and Low-No Emissions grant programs. Zero Emission Buses are more efficient, have lower energy consumption compared to ICE vehicles, lower maintenance costs, lower fuel cost in some parts of the country, quieter and preferred by passengers and use a US-produced fuel source.

China Thomas, Gwinnett County Director of Transit Capital Projects, gave the Board an update on rebranding Gwinnett's transit system. It was formally Gwinnett County Transit and will now be known as RIDE Gwinnett. This rebranding aligns with the County's vibrant brand. It connects residents to the places they need to go and increases awareness about mobility options across the county. Future plans for RIDE Gwinnett include adding three new local routes and two microtransit service zones, transit expansion and additional planning efforts to further expand transit network.

MARTA REACH APP/PILOT PROJECT

Anthony Thomas, MARTA Program Manager of Customer Experience Innovation, gave the Board an overview of the MARTA Reach App/Pilot Program. This was a six-month pilot program which provided an on-demand rideshare servicing areas in West Atlanta, Belvedere Park, Gillem/Clayton and North Fulton. This pilot used shuttles to make it easier and faster for riders to get to and from their destinations using MARTA.
