Such Operators must develop and annually update a PTASP that includes the processes and procedures to implement a Safety Management System, a comprehensive, collaborative and systematic approach to managing safety. Updates to the plan include:

- Transit Business Unit Org Chart and the SRTA/ATL Org Chart
- Sets 2024 Safety Performance Targets
- Revises membership of the PTASP Joint Management/Labor Safety Committee to include:
 - 3 ATL Xpress Managers
 - o 3 frontline employees

Mr. Mosby called for a motion to recommend the Resolution Approving the 2023 Update to the Xpress Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan. Mr. Weyandt made the motion, and Mr. Russell seconded. The Committee unanimously voted to recommend the resolution to the Board.

REDEFINING THE RIDE XPRESS 2.0

Cain Williamson provided an overview of Redefining the Ride Xpress 2.0.
